2.(b) An economic development agency may extend the period 18 of confidentiality specified in subparagraph 1. paragraph (a) 19 for up to an additional 12 months upon written request from the 20 21 private corporation, partnership, or person who originally 22 requested confidentiality under this section and upon a finding 23 by the economic development agency that such private 24 corporation, partnership, or person is still actively considering locating, relocating, or expanding its business 25 26 activities in this state. Such a request for an extension in the period of confidentiality must be received prior to the 27 expiration of any confidentiality originally provided under 28 29 subparagraph 1. this section.
