5 Section 38. Section 320.0807, Florida Statutes, is amended
6 to read:

7 320.0807 Special license plates for Governor and federal
8 and state legislators.-

9 (1) Upon application by any member of the House of
10 Representatives of Congress and payment of the fees prescribed
11 by s. 320.0805, the department may ~~is authorized to~~ issue to
12 such member of Congress a license plate stamped "Official Member
13 ~~of~~ Congress" followed by the number of the appropriate
14 congressional district and the letters "MC," or any other
15 configuration chosen by the member which is not already in use.

16 Upon application by a United States Senator and payment of the

17 fees prescribed by s. 320.0805, the department may ~~is authorized~~
18 ~~to~~ issue a license plate stamped "USS," followed by the numeral
19 II in the case of the junior senator.

20 (2) Upon application by any member of the state House of

22 320.0805, the department may ~~is authorized to issue the such~~
23 state representative license plates stamped ~~in bold letters~~
24 "Official House State Legislator," followed by the number of the
25 appropriate House of Representatives district and the letters
26 "HR," or any other configuration chosen by the member which is
27 not already in use. Upon application by a state senator and
28 payment of the fees prescribed by s. 320.0805, the department
29 may ~~is authorized to issue license plates stamped in bold~~
30 ~~letters~~ "Official Senate State Senator," followed by the number
31 of the appropriate Senate district and the letters "SN," or any
32 other configuration chosen by the member which is not already in
33 use.

34 (3) Upon application by the Governor and payment of the
35 appropriate fees, the department may ~~is authorized to issue to~~
36 the Governor two license plates stamped ~~in bold letters~~ "Florida
37 1" and "Florida 2."

38 (4) License plates purchased under subsection (1),
39 subsection (2), or subsection (3) shall be replaced by the
40 department at no cost, other than the fees required by ss.
41 320.04 and 320.06(3)(b), when the person to whom the such plates
42 have been issued leaves the elective office with respect to
43 which the such license plates were issued. Within 30 days after

62 | department or chosen by the applicant if it is not already in

64 | (6) (a) Upon application by any former member of Congress
65 | or former member of the state Legislature, payment of the fees
66 | prescribed by s. 320.0805, and payment of a one-time fee of
67 | \$500, the department may issue a former member of Congress,
68 | state senator, or state representative a license plate stamped
69 | "Retired Congress," "Retired Senate," or "Retired House," as
70 | appropriate, for a vehicle owned by the former member.

71 | (b) To qualify for a Retired Congress, Retired Senate, or
72 | Retired House prestige license plate, a former member must have

73 served at least 4 years as a member of Congress, state senator,
74 or state representative, respectively.

75 (c) Four hundred fifty dollars of the one-time fee
76 collected under paragraph (a) shall be distributed to the
77 account of the citizen support organization established pursuant
78 to s. 272.129 and used for the benefit of the Legislative
79 Research Center and Museum at the Historic Capitol, and the
80 remaining \$50 shall be deposited into the Highway Safety
81 Operating Trust Fund.

82 (7) The department may create a unique plate design for
83 plates to be used by members or former members of the
84 Legislature or Congress as provided in subsections (2), (5), and
85 (6).

86 (8)+(6) Any person who does not make application for a
87 replacement license plate as required by subsection (4), or who,
88 after receipt of the replacement license plate, continues to
89 display on any vehicle the prestige license plate or plates
90 issued with respect to his or her former office, is guilty of a
91 misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s.
92 775.082 or s. 775.083.
