7 Section 44. Section 322.145, Florida Statutes, is created  
8 to read:

9 322.145 Electronic authentication of licenses.

10 The department is directed to issue a supplementary  
11 procurement for the purpose of creating an electronic  
12 authentication feature for all driver licenses and  
13 identification cards issued by the department. The electronic  
14 authentication feature must conform to recognized technology  
15 standards but may not include the use of radio-frequency  
16 identification devices for licenses or identification cards. If  
17 the department chooses to contract with any vendor to implement  
18 an electronic authentication feature as described in this  
19 paragraph, the contract shall not conflict with any contracts

20 already entered into by the department for the issuance of  
21 driver licenses or identification cards. In addition, any  
22 potential contract for an electronic authentication feature must  
23 require all expenses related to the program to be the sole
