5 Remove lines 72-104 and insert:

6 through June 30, 2020, the division shall from month to month
 7 certify to the Chief Financial Officer the amount derived from
 8 the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, less the service charges
 9 provided for in s. 215.20 and less 0.9 percent of the amount
 10 derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, which shall
 11 be deposited into the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund,
 12 specifying an amount equal to 2.75 percent of the net
 13 collections, and that amount shall be paid to the Board of
 14 Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research
 15 Institute, established under s. 1004.43, by warrant drawn by the
 16 Chief Financial Officer. These funds are appropriated monthly
 17 out of the Cigarette Tax Collection Trust Fund, to be used for
 18 lawful purposes, including ~~the purpose of~~ constructing,
 19 furnishing, ~~and~~ equipping, financing, operating, and maintaining

20 a cancer research and clinical and related facilities;
21 furnishing, equipping, operating, and maintaining other
22 properties owned or leased by facility at the University of
23 South Florida adjacent to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and
24 Research Institute; and paying costs incurred in connection with
25 purchasing, financing, operating, and maintaining such
26 equipment, facilities, and properties. In fiscal years 2004-2005
27 and thereafter, the appropriation to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer
28 Center and Research Institute authorized by this subparagraph
29 shall not be less than the amount that would have been paid to
30 the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute in
31 fiscal year 2001-2002, had this subparagraph been in effect.
