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Section 22. Paragraph (d) is added to subsection (1) of section 196.199, Florida Statutes, to read:

196.199 Government property exemption.-

- (1) Property owned and used by the following governmental units shall be exempt from taxation under the following conditions:
- (d) All property of municipalities is exempt from ad valorem taxation if used as an essential ancillary function of a facility constructed with financing obtained in part by pledging

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proceeds from the tax authorized under s. 212.0305(4) which is upon exempt or immune federal, state, or county property. Section 23. The exemption from ad valorem taxation created by the amendment in this act to s. 196.199, Florida Statutes, applies retroactively to the 2012 tax roll. ======= T I T L E A M E N D M E N T ========= And the title is amended as follows: Delete line 100 and insert:
