

1 A bill to be entitled
 2 An act relating to voluntary contributions on
 3 registration, driver license, and identification card
 4 forms; amending s. 320.02, F.S.; requiring the
 5 application forms for motor vehicle registration and
 6 renewal of registration to include language permitting
 7 the applicant to make a voluntary contribution to
 8 Autism Services and Supports and to Support Our
 9 Troops; providing that such contributions are not
 10 income for specified purposes; amending s. 322.08,
 11 F.S.; requiring the application forms for an original,
 12 renewal, or replacement driver license or
 13 identification card to include language permitting the
 14 applicant to make a voluntary contribution to Autism
 15 Services and Supports and to Support Our Troops;
 16 providing that such contributions are not income for
 17 specified purposes; providing an effective date.

 19 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 21 Section 1. Paragraphs (o) and (p) are added to subsection
 22 (15) of section 320.02, Florida Statutes, to read:

23 320.02 Registration required; application for
 24 registration; forms.—

26 (o) The application form for motor vehicle registration
 27 and renewal of registration must include language permitting a
 28 voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for Autism Services

29 and Supports. Such contributions must be transferred by the
 30 department each month to the Achievement and Rehabilitation
 31 Centers, Inc., Autism Services Fund.

32 (p) The application form for motor vehicle registration
 33 and renewal of registration must include language permitting a
 34 voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Support Our
 35 Troops, which shall be distributed monthly to Support Our
 36 Troops, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit organization.

 38 For the purpose of applying the service charge provided in s.
 39 215.20, contributions received under this subsection are not
 40 income of a revenue nature.

41 Section 2. Subsection (7) of section 322.08, Florida
 42 Statutes, is amended to read:

43 322.08 Application for license; requirements for license
 44 and identification card forms.—

45 (7) The application form for an original, renewal, or
 46 replacement driver ~~driver's~~ license or identification card shall
 47 include language permitting the following:

48 (a) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
 49 contribution shall be deposited into the Health Care Trust Fund
 50 for organ and tissue donor education and for maintaining the
 51 organ and tissue donor registry.

52 (b) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
 53 contribution shall be distributed to the Florida Council of the
 54 Blind.

55 (c) A voluntary contribution of \$2 per applicant, which
 56 shall be distributed to the Hearing Research Institute,

57 Incorporated.

58 (d) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
59 shall be distributed to the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation
60 International.

61 (e) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
62 shall be distributed to the Children's Hearing Help Fund.

63 (f) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
64 shall be distributed to Family First, a nonprofit organization.

65 (g) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Stop
66 Heart Disease, which shall be distributed to the Florida Heart
67 Research Institute, a nonprofit organization.

68 (h) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Senior
69 Vision Services, which shall be distributed to the Florida
70 Association of Agencies Serving the Blind, Inc., a not-for-
71 profit organization.

72 (i) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for
73 services for persons with developmental disabilities, which
74 shall be distributed to The Arc of Florida.

75 (j) A voluntary contribution of \$1 to the Ronald McDonald
76 House, which shall be distributed each month to Ronald McDonald
77 House Charities of Tampa Bay, Inc.

78 (k) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution
79 of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the League
80 Against Cancer/La Liga Contra el Cancer, a not-for-profit
81 organization.

82 (l) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to
83 Prevent Child Sexual Abuse, which shall be distributed to
84 Lauren's Kids, Inc., a nonprofit organization.

85 (m) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which
 86 shall be distributed to Prevent Blindness Florida, a not-for-
 87 profit organization, to prevent blindness and preserve the sight
 88 of the residents of this state.

89 (n) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution
 90 of \$1 per applicant to the state homes for veterans, to be
 91 distributed on a quarterly basis by the department to the State
 92 Homes for Veterans Trust Fund, which is administered by the
 93 Department of Veterans' Affairs.

94 (o) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to the
 95 Disabled American Veterans, Department of Florida, which shall
 96 be distributed quarterly to Disabled American Veterans,
 97 Department of Florida, a nonprofit organization.

98 (p) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for
 99 Autism Services and Supports, which shall be distributed to
 100 Achievement and Rehabilitation Centers, Inc., Autism Services
 101 Fund.

102 (q) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to
 103 Support Our Troops, which shall be distributed to Support Our
 104 Troops, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit organization.

 106 A statement providing an explanation of the purpose of the trust
 107 funds shall also be included. For the purpose of applying the
 108 service charge provided in s. 215.20, contributions received
 109 under paragraphs (b)-(q) ~~(b)-(e)~~ are not income of a revenue
 110 nature.

111 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
