When a landowner uses purple paint marks to identify a "no trespassing" area, those marks shall be accompanied by signs placed conspicuously at all places where entry to the property is normally expected or known to occur. Such signs must include the name of the owner, lessee, or occupant of the land. Additionally, the words "no trespassing" must appear prominently on such signs in letters of not less than 2 inches in height.
