Delete lines 118 - 131 and insert:

- d. Begins paying by income deduction, unless receiving unemployment compensation, social security disability payments, supplemental security income, or temporary cash assistance; and
 - 2. Pays any applicable delinquency fees.

If the obligor in non-IV-D cases enters into a written agreement for payment before the expiration of the 20-day period, the obligor must provide a copy of the signed written agreement to

the depository or the clerk of the court.

(3) If the obligor does not, within 20 days after the mailing date on the notice, pay the delinquency; τ enter into a written payment agreement; r comply with the subpoena, order to appear, order to show cause, or other similar order; begin paying by income deduction, unless receiving unemployment compensation, social security disability payments, supplemental security income, or temporary cash assistance; or file a motion to contest, the Title IV-D agency in IV-D cases, or the depository or clerk of the court in non-IV-D cases, shall file the notice with the
