ARTICLE I, SECTION 3

30 RELIGIOUS FREEDOM.-Proposing an amendment to the State 31 Constitution providing that no individual or entity may be 32 denied, on the basis of religious identity or belief, 33 governmental benefits, funding, or other support, except as 34 required by the First Amendment to the United States 35 Constitution, and deleting the prohibition against using 36 revenues from the public treasury directly or indirectly in aid 37 of any church, sect, or religious denomination or in aid of any sectarian institution. 38
