6 (1) There is created a Study Committee on Investor-Owned
 7 Water and Wastewater Utility Systems, which shall be composed of
 8 18 members designated and appointed as follows:

9 (a) The chair of the Public Service Commission, or a
 10 commissioner of the Public Service Commission designated by the
 11 chair, who shall serve as chair of the committee and shall be a
 12 nonvoting member of the committee.

13 (b) The Secretary of Environmental Protection, or his or
 14 her designee, who shall be a nonvoting member of the committee.

15 (c) The Public Counsel, or his or her designee, who shall
 16 be a nonvoting member of the committee.

17 (d) One Senator appointed by the President of the Senate.

18 (e) One Representative appointed by the Speaker of the
 19 House of Representatives.

21 (f) Two representatives of Class A investor-owned water or
22 wastewater utilities, appointed by the Governor.

23 (g) One representative of a Class B investor-owned water
24 or wastewater utility, appointed by the Governor.

25 (h) One representative of a Class C investor-owned water
26 or wastewater utility, appointed by the Governor.

27 (i) One customer of a Class A investor-owned water or
28 wastewater utility, appointed by the Governor.

29 (j) One customer of a Class B or C investor-owned water or
30 wastewater utility, appointed by the Governor.

31 (k) One representative of a water management district,
32 appointed by the Governor.

33 (l) One representative of the Florida Section of the
34 American Water Works Association, appointed by the Governor.

35 (m) One representative of the Florida Rural Water
36 Association, appointed by the Governor.

37 (n) One representative of a water or wastewater system
38 owned or operated by a municipal or county government, appointed
39 by the Governor.

40 (o) One representative of a governmental authority created
41 pursuant to chapter 163, Florida Statutes, appointed by the
42 Governor.

43 (p) The chair of a county commission that regulates
44 investor-owned water or wastewater utility systems, appointed by
45 the Governor.

46 (q) A representative of a county health department,
47 appointed by the Governor.
