The Committee on Budget Subcommittee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development Appropriations (Bogdanoff) recommended the following:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Delete lines 1701 - 1748  
and insert:

~~Innovation~~ shall contract with one ~~or more~~ consumer reporting agency agencies to provide users with secured electronic access to employer-provided information relating to the quarterly wages report submitted in accordance with the state's reemployment assistance ~~unemployment compensation~~ law. The access is limited to the wage reports for the appropriate amount of time for the purpose the information is requested.

12 (2) Users must obtain consent in writing or by electronic  
13 signature from an applicant for credit, employment, or other  
14 permitted purposes. Any written or electronic signature consent  
15 from an applicant must be signed and must include the following:

16 (c) Notice that the files of the Department of Economic  
17 Opportunity Agency for Workforce Innovation or its tax  
18 collection service provider containing information concerning  
19 wage and employment history which is submitted by the applicant  
20 or his or her employers may be accessed; and

21 (4) If a consumer reporting agency or user violates this  
22 section, the Department of Economic Opportunity Agency for  
23 Workforce Innovation shall, upon 30 days' written notice to the  
24 consumer reporting agency, terminate the contract established  
25 between the department Agency for Workforce Innovation and the  
26 consumer reporting agency or require the consumer reporting  
27 agency to terminate the contract established between the  
28 consumer reporting agency and the user under this section.

29 (5) The Department of Economic Opportunity Agency for  
30 Workforce Innovation shall establish minimum audit, security,  
31 net worth, and liability insurance standards, technical  
32 requirements, and any other terms and conditions considered  
33 necessary in the discretion of the state agency to safeguard the  
34 confidentiality of the information released under this section  
35 and to otherwise serve the public interest. The department  
36 Agency for Workforce Innovation shall also include, in  
37 coordination with any necessary state agencies, necessary audit  
38 procedures to ensure that these rules are followed.

39 (6) In contracting with one ~~or more~~ consumer reporting  
40 agency agencies under this section, any revenues generated by

41 the contract must be used to pay the entire cost of providing  
42 access to the information. Further, in accordance with federal  
43 regulations, any additional revenues generated by the Department  
44 of Economic Opportunity Agency for Workforce Innovation or the  
45 state under this section must be paid into the Administrative  
46 Trust Fund of the department Agency for Workforce Innovation for  
47 the administration of the unemployment compensation system or be  
48 used as program income.

49 (7) The Department of Economic Opportunity Agency for  
50 Workforce Innovation may not provide wage and employment history  
51 information to any consumer reporting agency before the consumer
