House Memorial

A memorial to the Congress of the United States, urging Congress to stop the increase to the federal loan guarantee program for new nuclear reactors and rescind the remaining funds, eliminate the funding for mixed oxide plutonium fuel plants, support energy efficiency and renewable sources of energy and fund nuclear waste immobilization, increase funding for environmental cleanup programs, and direct the United States Department of Energy to comply with all cleanup agreements and legacy management requirements.

WHEREAS, the President of the United States and the United States Congress have taken the positive step of ending all funding for the Yucca Mountain nuclear repository site, which has already cost taxpayers \$96.2 billion, in an effort to provide taxpayers relief and protect our environment, and

WHEREAS, taxpayer dollars are being spent to fund the construction of mixed oxide plutonium fuel plants which will only exacerbate the environmental degradation of the areas surrounding the sites, and

WHEREAS, investing in cheaper, faster, cleaner, and safer renewable energy alternatives other than nuclear power and immobilizing nuclear waste should be our foremost economic and national security priority, and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding for environmental cleanup is necessary to ensure compliance with cleanup agreements and legacy management requirements, and
