Delete lines 222 - 226

and insert:

b. Domestic violence, as defined in s. 741.28, which causes the individual to reasonably believe that continued employment will jeopardize the individual's safety or the safety of a member of her or his immediate family. Such cause must be substantiated by evidence that reasonably proves that domestic violence has occurred, such as an injunction, protective order, or other such reasonable and confidential documentation authorized by state law. 12
