25	state funds, provide a detailed report of the organization's
26	total actual expenditures for the fiscal year in which the funds

30	(b) Expenditures made for vehicles, travel, educational

36	(2) The report required by this section shall be submitted
37	electronically and posted on the Florida Fiscal Portal website
38	in the form and manner prescribed jointly by the President of
39	the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
