Immediately following Specific Appropriation 55, DELETE:

Funds in Specific Appropriation 55 are provided to support 3,013 students at \$602 per student and shall be administered pursuant to section 1009.891, Florida Statutes. The Office of Student Financial Assistance may prorate the award and provide a lesser amount in the second term if the funds appropriated are insufficient to provide a full award to all eligible students. The Office of Student Financial Assistance may also reallocate funds between institutions if an eligible institution fails to reach its 2012-13 enrollment.

AND INSERT:

Funds in Specific Appropriation 55 are provided to support 3,013

students at \$1,089 per student and shall be administered pursuant to section 1009.891, Florida Statutes. The Office of Student Financial Assistance may prorate the award and provide a lesser amount in the second term if the funds appropriated are insufficient to provide a full award to all eligible students. The Office of Student Financial Assistance may also reallocate funds between institutions if an eligible institution fails to reach its 2012-2013 enrollment.

Following Specific Appropriation 56, DELETE:

From the funds provided in Specific Appropriation 56, \$5,608,800 shall be used for tuition assistance for qualified Florida residents at newly eligible institutions. These funds are provided to support 3,800 students at \$1,476 per student.

AND INSERT:

From the funds provided in Specific Appropriation 56, \$4,138,200 shall be used for tuition assistance for qualified Florida residents at newly eligible institutions. These funds are provided to support 3,800 students at \$1,089 per student.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
