The Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability (Ring) recommended the following:

## Senate Amendment

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Delete lines 3108 - 3125 and insert:

112.920 <del>110.1225</del> Furloughs.—If When a deficit is projected or certified to occur by the Revenue Estimating Conference pursuant to s.  $216.221 \frac{216.136(3)}{7}$  in any state agency fund that supports salary and benefit appropriations for state employees, the affected state agency or the judicial branch, upon approval of the Governor or the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, as applicable, Administration Commission may propose a furlough plan and related budget amendments for consideration by the

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Legislative Budget Commission. The commission, after consulting with the Revenue Estimating Conference regarding the projected deficit, may to the Legislature, which must approve or disapprove such plan and budget amendments in total. This section is subject to the notice and review procedures set forth in s. 216.177. The plan must identify all affected positions and ensure that all affected employees within a budget entity are subject to the same reduction of hours for the same number of pay periods with a commensurate reduction in pay.

- (1) If authorized by the Legislature as a cost-savings measure to address anticipated short-term shortfalls to funds that support salary and benefit appropriations for state employees for a specified fiscal year, a state agency or the judicial branch may also impose furloughs as directed by the Legislature in the General Appropriations Act.
- (2) For the purposes of this section, the term "furlough" means a temporary reduction in the regular hours of employment administered as leave without pay.
