717.108 Deposits held by utilities.-

9 <u>(1)</u> Any deposit, including any interest thereon, made by a 10 subscriber with a utility to secure payment or any sum paid in 11 advance for utility services to be furnished, less any lawful 12 charges, <u>which that</u> remains unclaimed by the owner for more than 13 1 year after termination of the services for which the deposit
