A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the state employees' prescription drug program; amending s. 110.12315, F.S.; requiring the Department of Management Services to authorize certain pharmacies to dispense 90-day maintenance prescription medication to certain patients; specifying a dispensing fee for a 90-day prescription supply; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (3) through (7) of section 110.12315, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (4) through (8), respectively, and a new subsection (3) is added to that section to read:

110.12315 Prescription drug program.—The state employees' prescription drug program is established. This program shall be administered by the Department of Management Services, according to the terms and conditions of the plan as established by the relevant provisions of the annual General Appropriations Act and implementing legislation, subject to the following conditions:

any retail pharmacy licensed in this state and participating in the program to dispense a 90-day maintenance prescription medication to a program member, subscriber, or covered dependent with a chronic disease, including, but not limited to, heart disease, diabetes, HIV/AIDS, end-stage renal disease, or cancer. The dispensing fee for a 90-day supply shall be 1.5 times the
