7 (9) (a) Once every two years the Auditor General shall
8 compare the department's records of disabled parking permit
9 holders with death records maintained by the Department of
10 Health. The Auditor General shall forward a list of disabled
11 parking permit holders who are deceased to the department and
12 the department shall promptly invalidate the decedent's disabled
13 parking permit.

14 (10) The department shall develop and implement a means by
15 which persons can report abuse of disabled parking permits by
16 telephone hotline or by submitting a form online or by mail.
