**Amendment**

Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. The facts stated in the preamble to this act are found and declared to be true.

Section 2. The insurer of the Sheriff of Broward County has agreed to pay, and is authorized and directed to pay, \$10,750,000 on behalf of the Broward County Sheriff's Office to the Guardianship of Eric Brody to be placed in a special needs trust created for the exclusive use and benefit of Eric Brody as compensation by the Broward County Sheriff's Office and its insurer, Fairmont Specialty Insurance Company, f/k/a Ranger Insurance Company, for injuries brought about by the facts set forth in the preamble of this act.

16       Section 3. The amount awarded under this act is intended  
17 to provide the sole compensation for all present and future  
18 claims, including all attorney fees, lobbying fees, and related  
19 costs, arising out of the factual situation described in this  
20 act which resulted in the injuries to Eric Brody, and hereby  
21 releases the Broward County Sheriff's Office and Fairmont  
22 Specialty Insurance Company, f/k/a Ranger Insurance Company, the  
23 Broward County Board of County Commissioners, Broward County,  
24 and Christopher Thieman from any further liability. The total  
25 amount of attorney fees, lobbying fees, and related costs may  
26 not exceed 15 percent of the first \$1,000,000 awarded under this  
27 act, 10 percent of the second \$1,000,000 awarded under this act,  
28 and 5 percent of the next \$3,000,000 awarded under this act, for  
29 a total of \$400,000.

30       Section 4. It is the intent of the Legislature that the  
31 lien interests relating to the claim of the Guardianship of Eric  
32 Brody for the treatment and care of Eric Brody, including  
33 Medicaid liens in excess of the sovereign immunity cap, are  
34 hereby waived or extinguished.

35       Section 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
