(i) Epinephrine use and supply.-

A student who has experienced or is at risk for life-16 threatening allergic reactions may carry an epinephrine autoinjector and self-administer epinephrine by auto-injector while 17 in school, participating in school-sponsored activities, or in 18 19 transit to or from school or school-sponsored activities if the 20 school has been provided with parental and physician 21 authorization. The State Board of Education, in cooperation with 22 the Department of Health, shall adopt rules for such use of 23 epinephrine auto-injectors that shall include provisions to 24 protect the safety of all students from the misuse or abuse of 25 auto-injectors. A school district, county health department, 26 public-private partner, and their employees and volunteers shall be indemnified by the parent of a student authorized to carry an 27 28 epinephrine auto-injector for any and all liability with respect 29 to the student's use of an epinephrine auto-injector pursuant to 30 this paragraph.

31 2. A public school may maintain in a locked, secure 32 location on its premises a supply of epinephrine auto-injectors. 33 A physician may prescribe epinephrine auto-injectors in the name 34 of the school to be maintained for emergency use when any 35 student is having an anaphylactic reaction.
