7 474.202 Definitions.—As used in this chapter:

8 (6) "Limited-service veterinary medical practice" means
9 offering or providing veterinary services, including
10 microchipping, at any location that has a primary purpose other
11 than that of providing veterinary medical service at a permanent
12 or mobile establishment permitted by the board; provides
13 veterinary medical services for privately owned animals that do
14 not reside at that location; operates no more frequently than
15 once every 2 weeks for 8 hours at a single location where a
