 13 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (4) of section
 14 828.27, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

15 828.27 Local animal control or cruelty ordinances;

18 (b) The governing body of a county or municipality
 19 enacting an ordinance relating to animal control or cruelty
 20 shall ~~may~~ impose and collect a surcharge of \$15 ~~up to \$5~~ upon
 21 each civil penalty imposed for each violation of the an
 22 ~~ordinance relating to animal control or cruelty.~~ One dollar of
 23 the surcharge may be retained by the clerk of the court, \$5 of
 24 the surcharge ~~proceeds from such surcharges~~ shall be used to pay
 25 the costs of training for animal control officers, and the
 26 remainder of the surcharge shall be used to subsidize the costs
 27 of spaying or neutering dogs and cats whose owners voluntarily
 28 submit their animals for sterilization. Owners of such animals

29 may not be charged more for the spaying or neutering than the
30 cost of sterilization less the subsidy paid from the surcharge.
31 This paragraph does not require the governing body of a county
32 or municipality to enact such an ordinance.

33 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
