4 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

5 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (5) of section  
6 790.06, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

7 790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.—

8 (5) The applicant shall submit to the Department of  
9 Agriculture and Consumer Services:

10 (b) A nonrefundable license fee not to exceed \$70 ~~\$85~~, if  
11 he or she has not previously been issued a statewide license, or  
12 a nonrefundable license fee not to exceed \$60 ~~\$70~~ for renewal of  
13 a statewide license. Costs for processing the set of  
14 fingerprints as required in paragraph (c) shall be borne by the  
15 applicant. However, an individual holding an active  
16 certification from the Criminal Justice Standards and Training

17 Commission as a "law enforcement officer," "correctional  
18 officer," or "correctional probation officer" as defined in s.  
19 943.10(1), (2), (3), (6), (7), (8), or (9) is exempt from the  
20 licensing requirements of this section. If any individual  
21 holding an active certification from the Criminal Justice  
22 Standards and Training Commission as a "law enforcement  
23 officer," a "correctional officer," or a "correctional probation  
24 officer" as defined in s. 943.10(1), (2), (3), (6), (7), (8), or  
25 (9) wishes to receive a concealed weapons or firearms license,  
26 such person is exempt from the background investigation and all  
27 background investigation fees, but shall pay the current license  
28 fees regularly required to be paid by nonexempt applicants.  
29 Further, a law enforcement officer, a correctional officer, or a  
30 correctional probation officer as defined in s. 943.10(1), (2),  
31 or (3) is exempt from the required fees and background  
32 investigation for a period of 1 year subsequent to the date of  
33 retirement of said officer as a law enforcement officer, a  
34 correctional officer, or a correctional probation officer.

35 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012.
