In Section 06, on Page 335, INSERT the following:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 2872, and authorized under section 365.172(9), Florida Statutes, \$250,000 shall be appropriated to the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office for the acquisition, implementation and maintenance of a real-time interoperability emergency computer aided design system pilot project in Duval, St. Johns, Clay, Nassau, and Baker counties, for one year, to facilitate improved functions of database management, call taking, dispatching, location verification, and call transfers across multiple and disparate CAD systems and jurisdictions.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
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
