Following Specific Appropriation 84, DELETE:

From the funds provided in Specific Appropriations 6 and 84, \$211,715,442 is provided for Instructional Materials including \$11,670,525 for Library Media Materials and \$3,189,944 for the purchase of science lab materials and supplies. The growth allocation per FTE shall be \$290.88 for Fiscal Year 2012-2013. School districts shall pay for instructional materials used for the instruction of public high school students who are earning credit toward high school graduation under the dual enrollment program as provided in section 1011.62(1)(i), Florida Statutes.

AND INSERT:

From the funds provided in Specific Appropriations 6 and 84, \$211,715,442 is provided for Instructional Materials including \$11,670,525 for Library Media Materials and \$3,189,944 for the purchase of science lab materials and supplies. The growth allocation per FTE shall be \$290.88 for Fiscal Year 2012-2013. School districts shall pay

for instructional materials used for the instruction of public high school students who are earning credit toward high school graduation under the dual enrollment program as provided in section 1011.62(1)(i), Florida Statutes. Each school district shall provide a report by August 1, 2012 to the Department of Education on the number and the replacement cost of textbooks that were not returned or were destroyed during the prior school year.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
