Following Specific Appropriation 1863A, INSERT:

From the funds in Specific Appropriation 1863A, the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission in cooperation with the Department of Environmental Protection, the St. Johns River Water Management District, the Lake County Water Authority, and the University of Florida, shall develop a prioritized list of restoration projects designed to improve the water quality and ecology in Lake Apopka. Prior to the expenditure of any funds, the prioritized list of projects must be submitted and approved by the Chair of the Senate Budget Subcommittee on General Government Appropriations and the Chair of the House Agriculture and Natural Resources Appropriations Committee.

Line item amendments are accepted as part of the amendatory process. However, due to the necessity of using computerized systems this may entail a different placement within a budget entity or the renumbering of the specific appropriation items.
