4 Remove lines 401-421 and insert:

5 Section 6. Subsections (1), (8), and (9) of section
6 322.21, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

7 322.21 License fees; procedure for handling and collecting
8 fees.—

9 (1) Except as otherwise provided herein, the fee for:

10 (a) An original or renewal commercial driver's license is
11 \$67 ~~\$75~~, which shall include the fee for driver education
12 provided by s. 1003.48. However, if an applicant has completed
13 training and is applying for employment or is currently employed
14 in a public or nonpublic school system that requires the
15 commercial license, the fee is the same as for a Class E

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16 driver's license. A delinquent fee of \$1 ~~\$15~~ shall be added for
17 a renewal within 12 months after the license expiration date.

18 (b) An original Class E driver's license is \$27 ~~\$48~~, which
19 includes the fee for driver's education provided by s. 1003.48.
20 However, if an applicant has completed training and is applying
21 for employment or is currently employed in a public or nonpublic
22 school system that requires a commercial driver license, the fee
23 is the same as for a Class E license.

24 (c) The renewal or extension of a Class E driver's license
25 or of a license restricted to motorcycle use only is \$20 ~~\$48~~,
26 except that a delinquent fee of \$1 ~~\$15~~ shall be added for a
27 renewal or extension made within 12 months after the license
28 expiration date. The fee provided in this paragraph includes the
29 fee for driver's education provided by s. 1003.48.

30 (d) An original driver's license restricted to motorcycle
31 use only is \$27 ~~\$48~~, which includes the fee for driver's
32 education provided by s. 1003.48.

33 (e) A replacement driver's license issued pursuant to s.
34 322.17 is \$10 ~~\$25~~. Of this amount \$7 shall be deposited into the
35 Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund and \$3 ~~\$18~~ shall be
36 deposited into the General Revenue Fund. Beginning July 1, 2015,
37 or upon completion of the transition of driver's license
38 issuance services, if the replacement driver's license is issued
39 by the tax collector, the tax collector shall retain the \$7 that
40 would otherwise be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating
41 Trust Fund and the remaining revenues shall be deposited into
42 the General Revenue Fund.

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43 (f) An original, renewal, or replacement identification
44 card issued pursuant to s. 322.051 is \$10 ~~\$25~~. Funds collected
45 from these fees shall be distributed as follows:

46 1. For an original identification card issued pursuant to
47 s. 322.051, the fee is \$10 ~~\$25~~. This amount shall be deposited
48 into the General Revenue Fund.

49 2. For a renewal identification card issued pursuant to s.
50 322.051, the fee is \$10 ~~\$25~~. Of this amount, \$6 shall be
51 deposited into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund and \$4
52 ~~\$19~~ shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund.

53 3. For a replacement identification card issued pursuant
54 to s. 322.051, the fee is \$10 ~~\$25~~. Of this amount, \$9 shall be
55 deposited into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund and \$1
56 ~~\$16~~ shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund. Beginning
57 July 1, 2015, or upon completion of the transition of the
58 driver's license issuance services, if the replacement
59 identification card is issued by the tax collector, the tax
60 collector shall retain the \$9 that would otherwise be deposited
61 into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund and the remaining
62 revenues shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund.

63 (g) Each endorsement required by s. 322.57 is \$7.

64 (h) A hazardous-materials endorsement, as required by s.
65 322.57(1)(d), shall be set by the department by rule and must
66 reflect the cost of the required criminal history check,
67 including the cost of the state and federal fingerprint check,
68 and the cost to the department of providing and issuing the
69 license. The fee shall not exceed \$100. This fee shall be

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70 deposited in the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund. The
71 department may adopt rules to administer this section.

72 (8) (a) Any person who applies for reinstatement following
73 the suspension or revocation of the person's driver's license
74 must pay a service fee of \$35 ~~\$45~~ following a suspension, and
75 \$60 ~~\$75~~ following a revocation, which is in addition to the fee
76 for a license. Any person who applies for reinstatement of a
77 commercial driver's license following the disqualification of
78 the person's privilege to operate a commercial motor vehicle
79 shall pay a service fee of \$60 ~~\$75~~, which is in addition to the
80 fee for a license. The department shall collect all of these
81 fees at the time of reinstatement. The department shall issue
82 proper receipts for such fees and shall promptly transmit all
83 funds received by it as follows:

84 1.(a) Of the \$35 ~~\$45~~ fee received from a licensee for
85 reinstatement following a suspension, the department shall
86 deposit \$15 in the General Revenue Fund and \$20 ~~\$30~~ in the
87 Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund.

88 2.(b) Of the \$60 ~~\$75~~ fee received from a licensee for
89 reinstatement following a revocation or disqualification, the
90 department shall deposit \$35 in the General Revenue Fund and \$25
91 ~~\$40~~ in the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund.

92 ~~(9) An applicant:~~

93 ~~(a) Requesting a review authorized in s. 322.222, s.~~
94 ~~322.2615, s. 322.2616, s. 322.27, or s. 322.64 must pay a filing~~
95 ~~fee of \$25 to be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating~~
96 ~~Trust Fund.~~

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97 ~~(b) Petitioning the department for a hearing authorized in~~
98 ~~s. 322.271 must pay a filing fee of \$12 to be deposited into the~~
99 ~~Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund.~~

100 (b) If the revocation or suspension of the driver's
101 license was for a violation of s. 316.193, or for refusal to
102 submit to a lawful breath, blood, or urine test, an additional
103 fee of \$115 ~~\$130~~ must be charged. However, only one \$115 ~~\$130~~
104 fee may be collected from one person convicted of violations
105 arising out of the same incident. The department shall collect
106 the \$115 ~~\$130~~ fee and deposit the fee into the Highway Safety
107 Operating Trust Fund at the time of reinstatement of the
108 person's driver's license, but the fee may not be collected if
109 the suspension or revocation is overturned. If the revocation or
110 suspension of the driver's license was for a conviction for a
111 violation of s. 817.234(8) or (9) or s. 817.505, an additional
112 fee of \$180 is imposed for each offense. The department shall
113 collect and deposit the additional fee into the Highway Safety
114 Operating Trust Fund at the time of reinstatement of the
115 person's driver's license.

116 Section 7. Subsection (2) of section 322.29, Florida
117 Statutes, is amended to read:

118 322.29 Surrender and return of license.—

119 (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), an examination is not
120 required for the return of a license suspended under s. 318.15
121 or s. 322.245 unless an examination is otherwise required by
122 this chapter. A person applying for the return of a license
123 suspended under s. 318.15 or s. 322.245 must present to the
124 department certification from the court that he or she has
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125 | complied with all obligations and penalties imposed pursuant to
126 | s. 318.15 or, in the case of a suspension pursuant to s.
127 | 322.245, that he or she has complied with all directives of the
128 | court and the requirements of s. 322.245 and shall pay to the
129 | department a nonrefundable service fee of \$47.50 ~~\$60~~, of which
130 | \$37.50 shall be deposited into the General Revenue Fund and \$10
131 | ~~\$22.50~~ shall be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating
132 | Trust Fund. If reinstated by the clerk of the court or tax
133 | collector, \$37.50 shall be retained and \$10 ~~\$22.50~~ shall be
134 | remitted to the Department of Revenue for deposit into the
135 | Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund. However, the service fee is
136 | not required if the person is required to pay a \$35 ~~\$45~~ fee or
137 | \$60 ~~\$75~~ fee under s. 322.21(8).
