(2) A license that has become inactive under subsection 8 (1) or for failure to complete the requirements in s. 473.312 may be reactivated under s. 473.311 upon application to the 9 department. The board may prescribe by rule continuing education requirements as a condition of reactivating a license. The minimum continuing education requirements for reactivating a license shall be those prescribed by board rule and those of the most recent biennium plus one-half of the requirements in s. 473.312. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the continuing education requirements are 120 hours, including at least 30 hours in accounting-related and auditing-related subjects, not more than 30 hours in behavioral subjects, and a 19 minimum of 8 hours in ethics subjects approved by the board, for
