2 A resolution recognizing the University of Florida
3 Men's Track and Field Team for winning the 2011
4 Division I Men's Indoor Track and Field Team National
5 Collegiate Athletic Association Championship.

7 WHEREAS, the University of Florida Gators have long been
8 recognized for their winning tradition in all intercollegiate
9 sports, and

10 WHEREAS, the University of Florida Men's Track and Field
11 Team has continued this tradition of athletic excellence,
12 achieved and maintained through hard work, determination, and a
13 team-first attitude, and

14 WHEREAS, the Florida Gators won their second NCAA Men's
15 Indoor Track and Field Championship on Saturday, March 12, 2011,
16 at Texas A&M University's Gilliam Indoor Track Stadium, scoring
17 52 total team points and beating Texas A&M University, Brigham
18 Young University, Louisiana State University, and Florida State
19 University, and

20 WHEREAS, under head coach Mike Holloway and his coaching
21 staff, and Athletic Director Jeremy Foley, the Florida Gators
22 came together to form a championship team, and

23 WHEREAS, the national championship won by the University of
24 Florida Men's Track and Field team marked the 25th national
25 title won by a Gator team in all sports, and only the fourth
26 men's program in NCAA history to claim back-to-back NCAA indoor
