**Amendment**

Remove lines 551-599 and insert:

Section 8. (1) This section shall take effect upon this act becoming a law.

(2) The powers, duties, functions, records, personnel, property, pending issues, existing contracts, administrative authority, administrative rules, and unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, and other funds of the Florida Council on Military Base and Mission Support within the Department of Economic Opportunity are transferred by a type two transfer, as defined in s. 20.06(2), Florida Statutes, to the Florida Defense Support Task Force within the Department of Economic Opportunity.

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16 Section 9. (1) This section shall take effect upon this  
17 act becoming a law.

18 (2) Section 288.984, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

19 Section 10. Effective upon this act becoming a law,  
20 subsections (1) and (2) of section 288.985, Florida Statutes,  
21 are amended to read:

22 288.985 Exemptions from public records and public meetings  
23 requirements.—

24 (1) The following records held by the Florida Defense  
25 Support Task Force Council on Military Base and Mission Support  
26 are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State  
27 Constitution:

28 (a) That portion of a record which relates to strengths  
29 and weaknesses of military installations or military missions in  
30 this state relative to the selection criteria for the  
31 realignment and closure of military bases and missions under any  
32 United States Department of Defense base realignment and closure  
33 process.

34 (b) That portion of a record which relates to strengths  
35 and weaknesses of military installations or military missions in  
36 other states or territories and the vulnerability of such  
37 installations or missions to base realignment or closure under  
38 the United States Department of Defense base realignment and  
39 closure process, and any agreements or proposals to relocate or  
40 realign military units and missions from other states or  
41 territories.

42 (c) That portion of a record which relates to the state's  
43 strategy to retain its military bases during any United States  
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44 Department of Defense base realignment and closure process and  
45 any agreements or proposals to relocate or realign military  
46 units and missions.

47 (2) Meetings or portions of meetings of the Florida  
48 Defense Support Task Force Council on Military Base and Mission  
49 ~~Support~~, or a workgroup of the task force council, at which  
50 records are presented or discussed which are exempt under  
51 subsection (1) are exempt from s. 286.011 and s. 24(b), Art. I  
52 of the State Constitution.
