Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 197.502, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

197.502 Application for obtaining tax deed by holder of tax sale certificate; fees.-

9 (1) The holder of a tax certificate at any time after 2 10 years have elapsed since April 1 of the year of issuance of the 11 tax certificate and before the cancellation of the certificate, 12 may file the certificate and an application for a tax deed with

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13	the tax collector of the county where the property described in		
14	the certificate is located. The tax collector may charge a tax		
15	deed application fee of \$75 and for reimbursement of the costs		
16	for providing online tax deed application services. If the tax		
17	7 collector charges a combined fee in excess of \$75, applicants
