Section 6. Section 48.062, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

48.062 Service on limited liability companies.--

- (1) Process against any limited liability company, domestic or foreign, may be served on the registered agent designated by the limited liability company under Chapter 608. A person attempting to serve process pursuant to this paragraph may serve the process on any employee of the registered agent during the first attempt at service even if the registered agent is a natural person and is temporarily absent from his or her office.
- (2) If service cannot be made on a registered agent of the limited liability company because of failure to comply with Chapter 608 or because the limited liability company does not have a registered agent, or if its registered agent cannot with

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- 20 reasonable diligence be served, process against the limited 21 liability company, domestic or foreign, may be served: (a) On any member of a member-managed limited liability 22 23 company; 24
 - (b) On any manager of a manager-managed limited liability company; or
 - (c) If a member or manager is not available during regular business hours to accept service on behalf of the limited liability company, he, she or it may designate an employee of the limited liability company to accept such service. After one attempt to serve a member, manager, or designated employee has been made, process may be served on the person in charge of the limited liability company during regular business hours.
 - (3) If, after reasonable diligence, service of process cannot be completed under subsection (1) or (2), service of process may be effected by service upon the Secretary of State as agent of the limited liability company as provided for in s. 48.181.
 - (4) If the address provided for the registered agent, member or manager is a residence or private mailbox, service on the limited liability company, domestic or foreign, may be made by serving the registered agent, member or manager in accordance with s. 48.031.
 - (5) This section does not apply to service of process on an insurance company regulated under ch. 624.
