5 Remove lines 45-61 and insert:

6 (3) This section does not apply to a member of a school's
 7 personnel who has been designated by the school principal of the
 8 school where the school's personnel is employed, or, for an
 9 administration building, by the district school superintendent,
 10 as authorized to carry a concealed weapon or firearm on school
 11 property.

12 (a) A designee authorized to carry a concealed weapon or
 13 firearm on such school property under this subsection may only
 14 carry such weapon or firearm in a concealed manner. The weapon
 15 or firearm must be carried on the designee's person at all times
 16 while the designee is performing his or her official school
 17 duties. Additionally, the designee must submit to the
 18 authorizing principal or authorizing superintendent proof of
 19 completion of training or experience as described in ss.
 20 493.6113(3)(b) and 493.6303(4).
