Section 1. Black Cultural Tourism Enhancement Commission
(1) There is created the Black Cultural Tourism
Enhancement Commission. The commission shall be administratively
housed within the Department of State but shall independently
exercise the powers and duties specified in this section. The
department staff shall provide administrative and staff support
services to the commission.
(2) The commission shall:
(a) Provide financial and technical assistance to
facilities and events that have the potential to expand tourism,
create jobs, and stimulate economic development in the state
through the marketing of the state's black cultural sites.
