6 (3) A person who is willfully using, or has willfully  
 7 used, a method, act, or practice in violation of this part  
 8 directed at a military service member or the spouse or child of  
 9 a military service member, is liable for a civil penalty of not  
 10 more than \$15,000 for each such violation if she or he knew or  
 11 should have known that her or his conduct was unfair or  
 12 deceptive.

 14 on a violation of this part committed against a senior citizen,  
 15 a ~~or handicapped~~ person who has a disability, a military service
