## 1 House Memorial

2 A memorial to the Congress of the United States,  
3 urging Congress to direct the National Marine  
4 Fisheries Service to withdraw its consideration of  
5 listing the queen conch as a threatened or endangered  
6 species.

8 WHEREAS, the importation, distribution, and sale of queen  
9 conch accounts for a significant percentage of the commerce and  
10 tourism industry in the southern region of Florida, and

11 WHEREAS, queen conch is a popular local delicacy that  
12 attracts millions of tourists to local restaurants, and

13 WHEREAS, Florida currently has long-term conservation  
14 measures to sustainably manage queen conch populations, and

15 WHEREAS, the harvesting of the queen conch in state waters  
16 and adjacent federal waters is prohibited, and

17 WHEREAS, the importation of queen conch from countries that  
18 do not have similar long-term conservation measures is  
19 prohibited, and

20 WHEREAS, those fisheries from which queen conch is  
21 currently imported are located in limited areas of federal and  
22 United States territorial waters and operate under strict  
23 regulations, and

24 WHEREAS, listing the queen conch as a threatened or  
25 endangered species would ban the legal importation of queen  
26 conch and have a detrimental impact on commerce and tourism in  
27 the southern region of Florida, NOW, THEREFORE,
