(b) A specialty-licensed children's hospital that has licensed neonatal intensive care unit beds and is located in a county with a population of 1,750,000 or more may provide obstetrical services, in compliance with the agency's rules pertaining to the obstetrical department in a hospital, to up to 10 beds for labor and delivery care, which services are restricted to the diagnosis, care, and treatment of pregnant women of any age who have documentation by an examining physician that includes information regarding:
