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1 Committee/Subcommittee hearing bill: Education Committee  
2 Representative Perry offered the following:

**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove lines 431-469 and insert:

6 (c)1. The FHSAA shall adopt bylaws that require all  
7 students participating in interscholastic athletic competition  
8 or who are candidates for an interscholastic athletic team to  
9 satisfactorily pass a medical evaluation each year before ~~prior~~  
10 ~~to~~ participating in interscholastic athletic competition or  
11 engaging in any practice, tryout, workout, or other physical  
12 activity associated with the student's candidacy for an  
13 interscholastic athletic team. Such medical evaluation may be  
14 administered only by a practitioner licensed under chapter 458,  
15 chapter 459, chapter 460, or s. 464.012, and in good standing  
16 with the practitioner's regulatory board. The bylaws must ~~shall~~  
17 establish requirements for eliciting a student's medical history  
18 and performing the medical evaluation required under this  
19 paragraph, which must ~~shall~~ include a physical assessment of the

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20 student's physical capabilities to participate in  
21 interscholastic athletic competition as contained in a uniform  
22 preparticipation physical evaluation and history form. The  
23 evaluation form must ~~shall~~ incorporate the recommendations of  
24 the American Heart Association for participation cardiovascular  
25 screening and must ~~shall~~ provide a place for the signature of  
26 the practitioner performing the evaluation with an attestation  
27 that each examination procedure listed on the form was performed  
28 by the practitioner or by someone under the direct supervision  
29 of the practitioner. The form must ~~shall~~ also contain a place  
30 for the practitioner to indicate if a referral to another  
31 practitioner was made in lieu of completion of a certain  
32 examination procedure. The form must ~~shall~~ provide a place for  
33 the practitioner to whom the student was referred to complete  
34 the remaining sections and attest to that portion of the  
35 examination. The preparticipation physical evaluation form must  
36 ~~shall~~ advise students to complete a cardiovascular assessment  
37 and must ~~shall~~ include information concerning alternative  
38 cardiovascular evaluation and diagnostic tests. Results of such  
39 medical evaluation must be provided to the school. No student  
40 shall be eligible to participate in any interscholastic athletic  
41 competition or engage in any practice, tryout, workout, or other  
42 physical activity associated with the student's candidacy for an  
43 interscholastic athletic team until the results of the medical  
44 evaluation have been received and approved by the school.

45 2. The FHSAA, in consultation with representatives from  
46 the American Heart Association, the American College of  
47 Cardiology, and the Florida Society of Pediatrics, shall develop

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48 an informational pamphlet on the risks of sudden cardiac arrest  
49 in young athletes. The pamphlet information should include, but  
50 not be limited to, the benefits of the collection of family  
51 history, electrocardiogram screening, and the use of the  
52 American Heart Association student athlete questionnaire  
53 guidelines. Beginning in the 2013-2014 school year, the FHSAA  
54 shall distribute a copy of the sudden cardiac arrest  
55 informational pamphlet to every potential student athlete in  
56 grades 9 through 12 for parental review. The FHSAA may partner  
57 with public or private entities for the production cost of the  
58 sudden cardiac arrest informational pamphlet.
