32	(c) Before sending a document, the sender verifies the
33	recipient's address by sending an electronic transmission to the
34	recipient and receiving an affirmative response from the
35	recipient verifying that the recipient's address is correct.
36	(d) If a document is returned as undeliverable, the sender
37	sends the document by regular mail, as required by law.
38	(e) Documents sent pursuant to this section comply with the
39	same timing and form requirements as if the documents were sent
40	by regular mail.
41	(f) The sender renews the consent and verification
