- (1) In order for a firefighter to retain his or her Firefighter Certificate of Compliance:
- (a) He or she must maintain a body mass index that does not exceed BMI 25. The firefighter's body mass index shall be evaluated during the regularly scheduled fitness tests as required under this part and shall be consistent with nationally accepted standards for measuring body mass index; and
 - (b) Every 4 years he or she must:
- 1. Be Any certified firefighter who has not been active as a firefighter, or as a volunteer firefighter with an organized fire department, for a period of 3 years shall be required to retake the practical portion of the minimum standards state

- 3. Successfully complete a refresher course consisting of a minimum of 40 hours of training to be prescribed by rule; or
- 4. Within 6 months before the 4-year period expires, successfully retake and pass the Minimum Standards Course examination.
