Amendment to Amendment (074723) (with title amendment)

Remove lines 67-86 and insert:

(3) Notwithstanding chapter 171 or any other applicable general law, special act, or ordinance, if a municipality annexes any unincorporated territory situated within the defined boundaries of a district and the district, under an automatic or mutual aid agreement, continues as a provider of fire, rescue, or emergency medical services for the annexed territory after the 4-year period provided in s. 171.093, the district shall be entitled to payment for such services. Any municipality that annexes such territory may levy any applicable taxes, assessments or fees on the annexed territory but must, by May 1 of each subsequent year following such annexation, pay the district for its services in an amount equal to the amount of

17 taxes, fees, or assessments which would have been collected by
 18 the district for such service from the annexed territory during
 19 that year had the territory not been annexed. Such payments
 20 shall continue unless the district is relieved of the fire,
 21 rescue, or emergency medical service responsibility in the
 22 annexed territory, with the exception of an isolated response to
 23 a local or areawide disaster, such as a hazardous material
 24 incident, natural disaster, or major fire.
