Between lines 1772 and 1773 insert:

Section 35. Paragraph (r) of subsection (7) of section 322.08, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

322.08 Application for license; requirements for license and identification card forms.-

10 (7) The application form for an original, renewal, or 11 replacement driver license or identification card shall include 12 language permitting the following:

shall be distributed to the Juvenile Diabetes Foundation
International.

(e) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, whichshall be distributed to the Children's Hearing Help Fund.

(f) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, whichshall be distributed to Family First, a nonprofit organization.

(k) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to the League Against Cancer/La Liga Contra el Cancer, a not-for-profit organization.

47 (1) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Prevent
48 Child Sexual Abuse, which shall be distributed to Lauren's Kids,
49 Inc., a nonprofit organization.

(m) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant, which shall be distributed to Prevent Blindness Florida, a not-forprofit organization, to prevent blindness and preserve the sight of the residents of this state.

(n) Notwithstanding s. 322.081, a voluntary contribution of
\$1 per applicant to the state homes for veterans, to be
distributed on a quarterly basis by the department to the State
Homes for Veterans Trust Fund, which is administered by the
Department of Veterans' Affairs.

(o) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to the
Disabled American Veterans, Department of Florida, which shall
be distributed quarterly to Disabled American Veterans,
Department of Florida, a nonprofit organization.

(p) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant for Autism
Services and Supports, which shall be distributed to Achievement
and Rehabilitation Centers, Inc., Autism Services Fund.

(q) A voluntary contribution of \$1 per applicant to Support
Our Troops, which shall be distributed to Support Our Troops,
Inc., a Florida not-for-profit organization.

69 (r) A voluntary contribution of \$1 or more per applicant to 70 the Auto Club Group Traffic Safety Foundation, Inc., a nonprofit 71 organization. Funds received by the foundation must be used to

80	under paragraphs <u>(b)-(r)</u> (b)-(q) are not income of a revenue
