At the end of existing proviso language, following Specific Appropriation 506, INSERT:

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From the funds in Specific Appropriation 506, \$600,000 in recurring general revenue funds is provided to Doctors' Memorial Hospital to serve the North Florida communities of Holmes, Jackson, Walton and Washington counties.
