A bill to be entitled

An act relating to Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program; amending s. 1002.67, F.S.; requiring the Department of Education to develop and adopt performance standards for students in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program which address the age-appropriate progress of students in the development of student learning growth; requiring measures of student learning growth to be based on interval data; requiring the State Board of Education to periodically align the performance standards for the statewide kindergarten screening to certain other standards and recommendations; amending s. 1002.69, F.S.; requiring the Department of Education to require a school district to administer the statewide kindergarten screening in a student's primary language; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 1002.67, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1002.67 Performance standards; curricula and accountability.—

- (1) (a) The department shall develop and adopt performance standards for students in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program. The performance standards must address the age-appropriate progress of students in the development of:
  - 1. The capabilities, capacities, and skills required under

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s. 1(b), Art. IX of the State Constitution; and

2. Emergent literacy skills, including oral communication, knowledge of print and letters, phonemic and phonological awareness, and vocabulary and comprehension development; and

- 3. Student learning growth as defined in s. 1012.34.

  Measures of student learning growth must be based on interval data.
- (b) The State Board of Education shall periodically review and revise the performance standards for the statewide kindergarten screening administered under s. 1002.69 and align the standards to the following standards and recommendations:
- $\underline{1.}$  Standards established by the state board for student performance on the statewide assessments administered pursuant to s. 1008.22.
- 2. Performance standards for children from birth to 5 years of age in school readiness programs pursuant to s. 411.01(4)(d).
- 3. Next Generation Sunshine State Standards that are based by rule on the Common Core State Standards from the National Governors Association Center for Best Practices and the Council of Chief State School Officers.
- 4. Recommendations of the Committee on Developmental
  Outcomes and Assessments for Young Children, a component of The
  National Academies.
- Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 1002.69, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
- 1002.69 Statewide kindergarten screening; kindergarten readiness rates; state-approved prekindergarten enrollment screening; good cause exemption.—
  - (1) The department shall adopt a statewide kindergarten

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screening that assesses the readiness of each student for kindergarten based upon the performance standards adopted by the department under s. 1002.67(1) for the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program. The department shall require that each school district administer the statewide kindergarten screening to each kindergarten student in the school district, in the student's primary language, within the first 30 school days of each school year. Nonpublic schools may administer the statewide kindergarten screening to each kindergarten student in a nonpublic school who was enrolled in the Voluntary Prekindergarten Education Program.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
