Section 2. Subsection (2) of section 1002.331, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:
1002.331 High-performing charter schools.(2) A high-performing charter school is authorized to:
(a) Increase its student enrollment once per school year by
up to 15 percent more than the capacity identified in the
charter, but student enrollment may not exceed the current

(b) Expand grade levels within kindergarten through grade 15 12 to add grade levels not already served if any annual enrollment increase resulting from grade level expansion is within the limit established in paragraph (a).

(c) Submit a quarterly, rather than a monthly, financialstatement to the sponsor pursuant to s. 1002.33(9)(g).

(d) Consolidate under a single charter the charters of multiple high-performing charter schools operated in the same school district by the charter schools' governing board regardless of the renewal cycle.

(e) Receive a modification of its charter to a term of 15 years or a 15-year charter renewal. The charter may be modified or renewed for a shorter term at the option of the highperforming charter school. The charter must be consistent with s. 1002.33(7)(a)19. and (10)(h) and (i), is subject to annual review by the sponsor, and may be terminated during its term pursuant to s. 1002.33(8).

32 A high-performing charter school shall notify its sponsor in 33 writing by March 1 if it intends to increase enrollment or 34 expand grade levels the following school year. The written 35 notice shall specify the amount of the enrollment increase and 36 the grade levels that will be added, as applicable. If a charter 37 school notifies the sponsor of its intent to expand, the sponsor 38 shall modify the charter within 90 days to include the new 39 enrollment maximum. The sponsor may deny a request to increase 40 the enrollment of a high-performing charter school if, after 41 requesting to expand, the charter school no longer qualifies as

43	high-performing charter school requests to consolidate multiple			
44	charters, the sponsor shall have 40 days after receipt of that			
45	request to provide an initial draft charter to the charter			
46	school. The sponsor and charter school shall have 50 days			
47	thereafter to negotiate and notice the charter contract for			
48	final approval by the sponsor.
