Section 22. Section 940.031, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

940.031 Clemency counsel when sentence of death has been imposed.-When a person has been sentenced to death, the Governor and Cabinet, acting as the Board of Executive Clemency, shall appoint counsel to represent the person for relief by executive clemency. The Board may not appoint a public defender, an office



of criminal conflict and civil regional counsel, or any capital collateral regional counsel under this section. The appointed attorney shall be compensated, not to exceed \$10,000, for attorney fees and costs incurred in representing the person for relief by executive clemency, with compensation to be paid out of the General Revenue Fund from funds budgeted to the Parole Commission. The Board shall maintain a list of counsel available for appointment under this section.
