The Committee on Appropriations (Hukill) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 91 and 92 insert:

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Section 3. Subsection (6) of section 212.03, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

212.03 Transient rentals tax; rate, procedure, enforcement, exemptions.-

(6) It is the legislative intent that every person is engaging in a taxable privilege who leases or rents parking or storage spaces for motor vehicles in parking lots or garages, including storage facilities for towed vehicles; who leases or



rents docking or storage spaces for boats in boat docks or marinas; r or who leases or rents tie-down or storage space for aircraft at airports is engaging in a taxable privilege.

- (a) For the exercise of this privilege, a tax is hereby levied at the rate of 6 percent on the total rental charged.
- (b) Charges for parking, docking, tie-down, or storage arising from a lawful impoundment are not taxable. As used in this paragraph, the term "lawful impoundment" means the storing of or having custody over an aircraft, boat, or motor vehicle by or at the direction of a local, state, or federal law enforcement agency which the owner or the owner's representative is not authorized to enter upon, have access to, or remove without the consent of the law enforcement agency.
