A bill to be entitled

An act relating to funerals, burials, and memorial services; creating s. 871.015, F.S.; providing a definition; prohibiting picketing or engaging in other protest activities within a specified distance of the property line of the location of a funeral, burial, or memorial service for certain persons; providing criminal penalties; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 871.015, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

871.015 Unlawful protests.-

- (1) As used in this section, the term "other protest activities" means any action that is disruptive or that is undertaken to disrupt or disturb a funeral, burial, or memorial service.
- (2) A person may not knowingly picket or engage in other protest activities or knowingly cause picketing or other protest activities to occur within 500 feet of the property line of a residence, cemetery, funeral home, house of worship, or other location during or within 1 hour before or 1 hour after the conducting at such places of a funeral or burial of, or a memorial service for, a military service member, an emergency response worker, an elected official, or a minor.
- (3) A person who violates this section commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s.
