14 or agency in this state.

21 support, or division of property in connection with an action to  
22 dissolve a marriage or with respect to an independent action for  
23 support of dependents, maintaining a matrimonial domicile in  
24 this state at the time of the commencement of this action or, if  
25 the defendant resided in this state preceding the commencement  
26 of the action, whether cohabiting during that time or not. This  
27 paragraph does not change the residency requirement for filing  
28 an action for dissolution of marriage.
